



Supporters' Code of Conduct

De La Salle Old Collegians Amateur Football Club (DLSOCAFC) is committed to providing men and women with the opportunity to play an enjoyable and competitive game of Australian Rules Football in a safe and supportive environment. This code of conduct has been developed to give supporters an understanding of their responsibilities to ensure these objectives are met.

All DLSOCAFC Supporters will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all individuals, by refraining from any discriminatory practices including, but not limited to, discrimination on the basis of race, religion, gender, ethnic background, special ability/disability or sexual orientation, preference or identity
- Respect umpires, officials and players by refraining from behaviour which may bring disrepute to the Club by:
 - Not abusing umpires, players or officials.
 - Controlling your temper and refraining from utilising inappropriate language which may impact the enjoyment of the game by others
 - Not deliberately provoking opposition players or officials including umpires
 - Avoiding any remarks that could be construed as offensive or discriminatory.
- Respect the facilities and the equipment provided.
- Not consume alcohol during VAFA games except at officially designated events.

Breach of this Code of Conduct

Any supporters who bring the DLSOCAFC into disrepute through breaching this Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the grounds by a Club Official.
